

ORGANISATION

The Organising Committee "**Triathlon 7C ASD – Trail Running 7C**" is pleased to announce the **Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run (CWCTR)**, to be held on **Sunday, 4 October 2026**.

The event will take place in a renewed format featuring brand-new courses over distances of **42 km, 21 km, 12 km and 7 km (Historical Walk)**.

ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

Participation in the **Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run** implies full and unconditional acceptance of these Regulations by all registered participants.

By registering, each participant agrees to comply with these Regulations and releases the Organising Committee from any civil or criminal liability for any accident, injury, loss or damage to persons or property occurring before, during or after the event, whether suffered by or caused by the participant.

The Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run will be held in accordance with these Regulations, together with any amendments and official notices published on the official website:

ELIGIBILITY

Participation in the **42 km** and **21 km** races is open to athletes who will be **18 years of age or older** on the day of the event and who meet the following requirements:

- Hold a valid **competitive sports medical certificate** for activities involving a high cardiovascular commitment, specifically covering **Athletics and/or Mountain Running**.

Certificates issued for **Ski Mountaineering, Skyrunning, Cross-Country Skiing and Trail Running** will also be accepted.

A copy of the medical certificate must be uploaded during the online registration process.

Should the certificate expire on or before **4 October 2026**, it is the athlete's responsibility to submit an updated and valid certificate by email to:

- Foreign athletes, whether affiliated or unaffiliated with their national federation, are required to submit the attached **"Annex 1 – Sport Medical Certificate"**, duly completed in all its parts.

For the **12 km** and **7 km Historical Walk**, **no competitive sports medical certificate is required**, as these events are classified as **non-competitive**.

Participation in the **12 km** race is open to anyone who is **14 years of age or older** on **4 October 2026**, provided that a declaration of responsibility is signed by a parent, legal guardian, coach or club official.

The maximum number of participants is:

- **300 runners** for the 42 km race
- **300 runners** for the 21 km race
- **300 participants** for the 12 km race

REGISTRATION

Registration for the **Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run** opens at **00:00 on 4 June 2026** and closes **30 minutes before the start of each race**, or earlier if all race bibs have been allocated.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE ON RACE DAY.

Registrations are managed by **ICRON Evolution** and may be completed:

THE ENTRY FEE INCLUDES

The registration fee includes:

- Medical assistance throughout the event;
- Aid stations along the course;
- One hot meal voucher (Pasta Party);
- One-day third-party liability insurance;
- Race bib with disposable timing chip;
- Official timing service;
- Free unattended parking close to the start/finish area;
- Shower facilities;
- Toilets available in the start/finish area;
- Official race pack;
- Supervised baggage storage;
- Finisher medal.

BIB TRANSFER – DISTANCE CHANGE – WITHDRAWAL

A race bib may be transferred to another participant **until 12:00 noon on 20 September 2026**, subject to payment of an administrative fee of **€5.00**, payable on race day.

To request a bib transfer, participants must send an email to:

including:

- the original participant's registration details;
- the new participant's personal details;
- a copy of the new participant's valid medical certificate.

Within the same deadline and following the same procedure, participants may also change from a **longer distance to a shorter one**.

No refund will be given for the difference in the entry fee.

In the event of withdrawal, **no refund will be granted**, nor may the registration be transferred to the **2028 edition**.

AWARDS – 42K • 21K • 12K

The overall **Men's and Women's Awards Ceremony** for the **CWCTR 42K** will take place **30 minutes after the last male and female podium finisher has crossed the finish line.**

The awards ceremony for all **age categories** in the **42K, 21K and 12K** races will be held at **2:00 p.m.**

For each race, the following rankings will be drawn up:

- Overall Women's Classification;
- Men's Age Category Classifications;
- Women's Age Category Classifications.

Prizes will consist of **local products and/or prizes offered by the event sponsors**.

Awards will be presented **only to athletes who are personally present at the awards ceremony**.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to establish additional awards at its sole discretion.

TIME LIMITS AND CUT-OFF TIMES

42K race only

The maximum time allowed to complete the race is **7 hours**.

Participants who reach any official **cut-off point** after the prescribed time limit will be **officially withdrawn from the race** and transported back to the finish area by the Organising Committee.

Participants who refuse transportation will be considered withdrawn from the competition and will no longer be under the responsibility of the Organising Committee.

In the event of adverse weather conditions or for safety reasons, the Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the cut-off times, including during the race.

Detailed cut-off times are available in the respective **Road Books** published on the official website.

For the **21K** and **12K** races **no cut-off times are established**.

RACE BIB AND RACE PACK COLLECTION

Each registered participant will receive a **Registration Confirmation Letter** by email.

The confirmation letter must be saved on a mobile device and presented **in digital format**, together with a valid identity document, when collecting the race bib.

The race bib is required to access all services reserved for participants.

Each participant must write on the back of the bib:

- the name of the emergency contact;
- the emergency contact's mobile phone number.

Participants are also required to save the **emergency telephone number printed on the race bib** in their mobile phone.

The race bib is **strictly personal** and **may not be transferred** to another person.

It is the participant's responsibility to wear the bib visibly on the **front of the torso** throughout the race.

Any modification, folding or cutting of the bib is strictly prohibited.

Participants found:

- without a bib;
- wearing an altered bib;
- using another participant's bib;

will be **immediately disqualified** and reported to the competent sporting and judicial authorities.

BIB DISTRIBUTION

Race Headquarters – Palaciclamino, Cesuna (Via Vecchia Stazione)

Saturday, 3 October 2026

17:00 – 19:00

Sunday, 4 October 2026

From **06:30** until **10 minutes before the official start** of each race.

ATHLETE'S OBLIGATIONS

Each participant is required to:

- Take part in the race wearing equipment suitable for trail running competitions. In particular, the use of **trail running shoes or equivalent footwear** is mandatory.
- Wear the race bib at all times during the race. The bib must not be altered, folded or cut and must remain clearly visible throughout the event.
- In the event of withdrawal from the race, immediately inform the nearest checkpoint or aid station.
- Follow the official marked course at all times.
- Carry throughout the race:
 - a windproof jacket;
 - an emergency thermal blanket;
 - a personal water supply with a minimum capacity of **0.5 litres**.
- Depending on weather conditions or forecasts, the Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the list of mandatory equipment by adding or removing items.
- Participants are **strongly advised** to carry an adequate personal supply of food and water throughout the race.

AID STATIONS

Along the **42K course**, in addition to the finish area, **five aid stations** will be available at the following locations:

- **Boscon Cemetery** (approximately 7.3 km from the start)
- **Barental Cemetery** (approximately 16.2 km)
- **Granezza Cemetery** (approximately 22.2 km)
- **Val Magnaboschi Cemetery** (approximately 32.5 km)
- **Campiello Austrian Military Cemetery** (approximately 37.5 km)

The exact locations of all aid stations are shown in the official **Road Books**, available on the event website:

To reduce the environmental impact of the event, **no disposable cups or containers will be provided** at the aid stations.

Each participant must carry a **collapsible cup, bottle or other suitable reusable container** for food and drinks.

The Organising Committee will only provide beverages for refilling personal bottles, cups or hydration systems.

Available refreshments include:

Drinks

- Still water
- Sparkling water
- Hot tea
- Electrolyte drinks
- Coca-Cola

Food

- Fresh fruit (bananas, oranges, apples)
- Dried fruit (apricots, raisins)
- Biscuits
- Chocolate
- Cheese
- Cold cuts
- Bread

Each aid station will also be equipped with a basic **First Aid Kit**.

Its contents are intended **exclusively for self-treatment**, and volunteers stationed at the aid stations shall not be held responsible for their use.

PARKING AND SHOWERS

Large **free unattended parking areas** are available close to the start and finish area in **Cesuna**.

Showers and toilets are available at the local football changing facilities, located approximately **2 km** from the event venue.

A shuttle transfer service will be available between the finish area and the shower facilities.

BAGGAGE STORAGE

A supervised baggage storage area will be available near the start line.

Participants may leave their bags before the race and collect them after finishing.

LIABILITY

By registering for the Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run, participants acknowledge that the event is a **physically demanding mountain trail running competition**.

Participants declare that:

- they have examined the race course;
- they are fully aware that the course mainly follows mountain trails and mule tracks;
- they have been adequately informed by the Organising Committee of the inherent risks associated with trail running;
- they consider themselves physically and technically capable of completing the race;
- they voluntarily accept all risks associated with participation.

Consequently, participants release the Organising Committee from any civil or criminal liability arising from their own conduct or from damage caused by them.

The Organising Committee accepts no responsibility for the loss or theft of personal belongings left unattended before, during or after the event, including in:

- the start/finish area;
- shower facilities;
- catering area;
- awards area.

PERSONAL MEDICAL INSURANCE

The Organising Committee provides **Third-Party Liability Insurance** covering the duration of the event.

Participants are strongly encouraged to purchase their own personal accident insurance.

A suitable insurance policy is available through the **International Trail Running Association (ITRA)** for registered members.

ENVIRONMENTAL CAMPAIGN

The Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run supports the environmental initiative:

"I Do Not Throw Away My Waste"

to help protect nature and the environment.

For this reason:

- disposable cups will not be provided at aid stations;
- every participant must carry a personal cup or bottle;
- all waste, including energy gel wrappers and similar items, must be disposed of only in the bins provided at the aid stations.

Participants reported for inappropriate environmental behaviour may be penalised or disqualified at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT – IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION

It is **strictly forbidden** to leave any kind of litter along the race courses.

Any participant found littering will be **immediately disqualified** and may also be subject to the penalties provided for by applicable law.

Particular attention is required when passing through the **Commonwealth War Cemeteries**, including those located near aid stations.

RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT – PERSONAL NUTRITION ITEMS

Participants carrying energy bars, gels or similar nutrition products are required to **clearly write their race bib number on each item**.

Should any item bearing a participant's race bib number be found abandoned along the course, the athlete concerned will be **immediately disqualified**.

ITRA POINTS

The following **International Trail Running Association (ITRA)** points will be awarded:

COURSE MODIFICATIONS AND EVENT CANCELLATION

The Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the race course or relocate aid stations and medical checkpoints at any time and without prior notice.

Should adverse weather conditions occur (including dense fog, severe thunderstorms or any other circumstance that may compromise participant safety), the Organising Committee may:

- postpone the start;
- cancel the event;
- modify the course;
- shorten the race distance;
- stop the race at any point along the course.

In the event of suspension, modification or cancellation of the event, **participants shall not be entitled to any refund of the entry fee.**

PRIVACY

By registering for the event, participants authorise the Organising Committee to process their personal data for purposes related to:

- registration management;
- timing services;
- publication of official results;
- insurance requirements.

Participants also expressly authorise the Organising Committee and its sponsors to use, free of charge, any photographs or video recordings in which they may appear for promotional and advertising purposes relating to the Commonwealth War Cemeteries Trail Run.

ANIMALS

To ensure the highest level of safety for all participants, **running with pets or any other animals is strictly prohibited.**

Failure to comply with this rule will result in the **immediate disqualification** of the participant.

AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend and/or supplement these Regulations at any time.

Any updates will be published:

- on the official website;
- on the official Facebook page;

and highlighted in **BOLD UPPERCASE TEXT** within this document.

PROTESTS

Only written protests signed by the participant will be accepted.

Protests must be submitted to the Organising Committee **no later than 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, 4 October 2026**, together with a **€50.00 deposit**.

The deposit will not be refunded if the protest is rejected.

The Protest Jury consists of:

- Race Director;
- Course Manager;
- Course Officials.

The Jury's decision shall be **final and not subject to appeal**.

Where necessary, investigations may continue after the event through the examination of photographs and video recordings.

ANNEX 1

SPORT MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

FOR PARTICIPANTS IN THE CWCTR 42K AND 21K RACES

The attached **Sport Medical Certificate** must be completed in full by a licensed physician for all foreign athletes whose national regulations require submission of a medical certificate.

The certificate must confirm that the athlete is medically fit to participate in a competitive trail running event and must be submitted together with the registration documentation.
